- Candidates reappearing in 10+2 can take provisional admission.

Weightages:

If 10+2 examination has been passed from a Rural Area of Haryana (5 marks)

- Students from 10+2 commerce applying for B.Com. will automatically get 5 % weightage added to their marks.
- Recipients of National Talent Award from the NCERT will get 5 marks.

- For B.Com. Ist Semester, Students who have passed 10+2 examinations with commerce **OR** N.C.C Cadets who possess the 'B' Certificate **OR** Holders of Bharat Scouts & Guides Certificate awarded by the President of India (for admission to under graduate course only) **OR** Sports Certificate for the admission to UG courses will get 5 marks.
- Additional 5 marks weightage to NSS Merit Certificate holder students of +2 class.

Admissions As Per National Education Policy 2020

- 1. Admissions in UG programmes shall be as per National Education Policy.**
- 2. All Honours UG programmes shall be of 4 years duration with multiple entry and exit option.**
